Position Expectations

Education: Knowledge of folkstyle, freestyle, and Greco wrestling styles. Experience coaching wrestling preferred.

Experience: Previous experience as a wrestler, coaching wrestling, and working with children preferred. High school and college wrestling experience a plus.

The position is year round 12-20 hours per week including some Saturdays.

The average work week will be between the hours of 3:30-7:30 pm Monday through Friday and some Saturdays. Scheduling is flexible and hours can vary.

Candidate must work effectively with others and must be comfortable in a room filled with active and diverse student-athletes. Able to multi-task, help many students at once, and help manage the room.

Description of Duties

Manage and run wrestling classes for K-5 age group including teaching skills and setting and achieving group advancement goals.

Support the goals of the CYC Wrestling Program by promoting our program to potential students and their families and evaluate the program for continuous improvement opportunities.

Maintain attendance and skill advancement records for our promotion system.

Help keep wrestling facilities welcoming and tidy.

Attend wrestling staff meetings.
