



Tutor for Elementary School Students

The Community Youth Center (CYC) in Concord, CA is a non-profit organization that offers several after-school programs for youth ages 3-18 to thrive in a dynamic and positive environment through sports and academic. CYC opened in September 1995 to provide such a place for the youth of Concord and the surrounding communities.

Each year, the CYC has continued to grow with more than 1,900 members participating today. CYC offers recreational and competitive programs, as well as an Academic Excellence Center. Combined, these programs help members manage their time effectively so they can become better students and athletes.

Position Description

The Academic Excellence Program at the CYC offers tutoring in several different academic subjects for student's grades 1st through 12th. The Big AE room, which serves students in grades 1st-6th, ages 5-11, is looking to hire a qualified, responsible, and reliable young adult to tutor elementary and middle school students with their homework and academic work. If necessary, you may also need to help students with reading, pronunciation, writing, and counting if they request. Depending on your availability and student attendance, you will work on average between 5-10 hours per week. The hours for employment are 3-8 pm Mondays through Thursdays and 3-6 pm on Fridays.

Qualifications/Requirements:

- Minimum age 16
- Qualified in at least 6th grade Math, Science, English,
- Willingness and ability to work with children ages 5-11.
- Pass a Live Scan Background Check
- Pass a Drug Test
- Ability to access our Concord campus by the start of your shift
