



Tutor for High School Students

The Community Youth Center (CYC) in Concord, CA is a non-profit organization that offers several after school programs for youth ages 3-18 to thrive in a dynamic and positive environment through sports and academic. CYC opened in September 1995 to provide such a place for the youth of Concord and the surrounding communities.

Each year, the CYC has continued to grow with more than 1,900 members participating today. CYC offers recreational and competitive programs, as well as an Academic Excellence Center. Combined, these programs help members manage their time effectively so they can become better students and athletes.

Position Description

The Academic Excellence Program at the CYC offers tutoring in several different academic subjects for students in grades 1st-12th. The High School AE room is searching for a qualified, responsible, and reliable young adult to tutor middle school and high school students, grades 7-12, ages 11-18 in different academic subjects. Depending on your availability and student attendance, you will work on average between 5-10 hours per week. The hours for employment are 3-8 pm Mondays through Thursdays, and 3-6 pm on Fridays.

Qualifications/Requirements:

- Senior in high school or Graduate of high school
- Qualified in at least 3 of the following academic subjects at the high school level. At least one must be a Math or Science subject: (Physics, General Chemistry, Biology, Geometry, Algebra 2 / Trigonometry, Pre-calculus, Calculus, History, English/Writing/Composition, and Spanish.
- Pass a Live Scan Background Check
- Pass a Drug Test
- Ability to access our Concord campus by the start of your shift
- Prior to starting the Tutor position, you will be required to take and pass a Tutor Test in order to check your qualifications.
